Section 504

Covenant Academy has a duty to locate, evaluate and identify students who qualify for Section 504 accommodations or services. Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act is a civil rights law that protects the rights of students with disabilities by preventing discrimination. 504 Plans are formal plans schools develop to give students with disabilities the support they need to assure equal access to education. 504 Plans cover any conditions that limit daily activity in a major way by implementing accommodations in, for instance, the school and classroom.
