Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER), which provides key information on the 2023-24 educational progress for Saginaw Covenant Academy. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information on student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. For the 2024-25 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2023-24. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2021-22. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state, had a graduation rate at or below 67%, or failed to exit ATS status in 2021-22. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school **has not** been given one of these labels.

The school is currently facing several key challenges, as highlighted in the 'Annual Education Report.' One of the primary concerns is the persistent achievement gap between different student subgroups, particularly among students from low-income backgrounds and students with disabilities. Data shows that while overall student performance has improved in certain areas, disparities remain, particularly in literacy and math proficiency. To address these challenges, the school has implemented several initiatives aimed at accelerating student achievement. These include the introduction of targeted interventions for struggling students. Additionally, the school is focusing on professional development for teachers, equipping them with the tools and strategies necessary to better support diverse learners. Another key initiative is the expansion of social-emotional learning programs to help students build resilience and engagement in their education,

which is crucial for closing achievement gaps. These efforts, combined with a strong emphasis on data-driven decision-making and ongoing monitoring of student progress, are designed to ensure that all students have the opportunity to succeed and thrive academically.

State law requires that we also report additional information.

- 1. Saginaw Covenant Academy is a year-round school with an open enrollment policy. The enrollment process involves completing an enrollment packet, a hearty orientation process in which the student and family are educated on the expectations of all students and other policies and procedures associated with being a student at SCA. All enrolling students are assigned to SCA, a one-building district.
- 2. Saginaw Covenant Academy is in its fourth year of an Academic Revamp as a part of its school improvement plan. Phase one of this Revamp included the implementation of a new curriculum, StrongMinds, and an instructional model that focuses on blended/hybrid learning. Phase two included more structured time in the classroom, moving from students taking one to two classes at a time and introducing five terms throughout the school year (as opposed to one-year long term). Phase three, which we are currently in, focuses on creating a guaranteed and viable curriculum. Throughout this phase, SCA will also significantly focus on developing a more hearty MTSS process and improving intervention programs and Tiered systems of support within the classrooms.
- 3. Saginaw Covenant Academy provides at-risk, dropout youth ages 15-22, the opportunity to earn a high school diploma, improve their life skills, and continue to post-secondary education or employment. SCA focuses on youth who are dropouts, homeless, living in poverty, teen parents or expectant parents, and those who have been disenfranchised by working to break down barriers so students have the opportunity to achieve their high school diploma. We offer a blended learning program and flexible, year-round classes that enable us to provide an individualized education for each student, allowing them to work at their own pace. Our staff works towards preventing poverty, underachievement, and homelessness for our students while offering hope, encouragement, and greater opportunities for success while on the path to earning their high school diploma.
- 4. SCA follows a blended instructional model. Our students use an online curriculum, StrongMind, which is housed in Canvas. Our highly qualified content area teachers deliver our students the Michigan Merit Curriculum (MMC). Copies of this curriculum can be obtained by contacting Chris Gray, the Director of Academics, Compliance, and Pupil Accounting.

- 6. Saginaw Covenant Academy does not have traditional parent-teacher conferences. Instead, we host regular events at the school, which students and their parents/guardians, when appropriate, are encouraged to attend. During these events, teachers can meet with parents and students to discuss academic progress. When students struggle academically, emotionally, engagement-wise, etc, the staff at SCA will meet with that student, including parents/guardians when appropriate, to discuss the present level and develop a plan for success.
- 7. Saginaw Covenant Academy has no students who are part of a dual enrollment program or Advanced Placement/International Baccalaureate classes or are currently taking courses that would lead to college credit.

In closing, I am proud of the accomplishments of our students and graduates. I am encouraged by all of our staff's continued hard work and dedication as they work to further the educational goals of our students. We continue to build and implement systems to enable all students to progress toward earning their diplomas and becoming SCA alumni who are successful and contributing citizens of our community.
